Major League All Star, Cy Young Award Winner and Hall of Famer Fergie Jenkins to speak in support of Cystic Fibrosis Canada and THEMUSEUM

Fergie Jenkins, born in Chatham Ontario, will speak about his major league experience and will take questions from the audience on the evening of Wednesday May 8th. Mr. Jenkins will then be available to sign autographs and pose to have his picture taken with guests. In addition, there will be both a silent and live auction with all proceeds going to support THEMUSEUM and Cystic Fibrosis Canada, as May is CF Awareness Month.

The event was spearheaded by local family lawyer Dave Morneau who is a dedicated baseball fan and has a family Membership at THEMUSEUM. Last May Farwell parachuted from an airplane to raise funds and raise awareness.
